#### - OVERVIEW –

**PURPOSE:** An assistance program that will have a long term impact on the individual and the community. To provide financial support for a person pursuing education beyond high school, to influence families towards greater financial independence, to build self-confidence and self-reliance that will make a positive impact on the future of the community and the individual. Scholarships will be based on student qualifications, financial need, and will apply to tuition and fees only.

**NOMINEES:** Seniors and graduates who have received a high school or GED diploma from an accredited school are eligible. All nominees must currently live within our six areas of service which are Ramona, Julian, Santa Isabel, Warner Springs, Borrego Springs and Ranchita and must be committed to continuing their academic careers beyond high school.

**<u>RECIPIENT(s)</u>**: Recipients of the award must be from a low or middle class income family, have demonstrated high academic potential, be a positive role model with leadership potential and have the high motivation necessary to succeed and complete a four-year college degree.

**<u>FUNDING</u>**: The Assistance Fund can be used to finance all or part of the program. If necessary, Thrift Store profits may be used to pay some or all of the program costs. Payments, made directly to the college, may be authorized in the following amounts at the beginning of each semester of full-time college enrollment:

- **\$1000 per semester for four-year** college or university students (maximum of eight continuous semesters) **up to \$8,000.** 

Any exceptions to the continuous semester hour requirement must be individually addressed to the Scholarship Committee.

- 6. All applicants are highly encouraged to volunteer at Ramona Food and Clothes Closet to understand and participate in the organization's purpose.
